

Visitor's Entry Visa

Visa Application Requirement

Malaysia nationals living in Malaysia who do not hold ordinary biometric passport with embedded microchip that is compliant with ICAO standards remain advised to obtain a visa to enter into Japan.

A stay of up to 90 days per entry for sightseeing and visiting friends or relatives, etc. that does not include paid activities.

Necessary documents for application:

1. One completely filled and signed "Visa Application Form To Entry Japan".
2. Original passport with validity at least six (6) months and minimum two (2) blank pages.
3. One (1) photo (4.5cm x 4.5cm) with white background printed on good quality paper, which is taken within six (6) months from the visa application and must be pasted on the application form.
4. Document which can prove your current residential address.
Example: Indication of present residential address in the certificate of employment (Original Company Letter)
Example: Original and one (1) photocopy utility bills or receipts.
5. One of the following sets of documents issued not more than three (3) months before the date of application:
 - (a) Certificate of employment (Original Company Letter) from your company stating your position, department in the company and length of service.
 - (b) Certificate of business registration and original company letter of your own company if you are self-employed.
 - (c) If you are a student aged sixteen (16) years old and above, you must submit a certificate of employment (Original Company Letter) of your parent.
 - (d) If you are a dependent (spouse or children), you must submit a certificate of employment of certificate of business registration and certificate of employment (Original Company Letter) of your spouse or guardian.
For those who are not working, please give an explanation in writing concerning your income.
6. Original certified true copy of the latest personal bank account statement such as savings book, current account statement, Tabung Haji, Amanah Saham Berhad (ASB) or fixed deposit belonging to yourself, your parents or your spouse.
Example: The minimum amount is MYR 6,000 balance imprinted with the bank officer's full name.
7. Copy of return or onward flight ticket & hotel voucher / Itinerary in Japan (if you are joining group package).
8. For transit purpose, copy of visa to the main destination country.
9. Document(s) to prove that you are a spouse or child of the main applicant.
Example: Marriage certificate for spouse, birth certificate for child.

Remarks:

1. Please do not send any document or material directly to the Embassy/Consulate General/Consular Office unless you are asked to do so.
2. If the documents submitted are insufficient or incomplete, Embassy/Consulate General/Consular Office may not be able to accept your application.
3. In some cases, Embassy/Consulate General/Consular Office may request for additional documents or call for an interview.
4. Please arrange all the documents according to the sequence. Documents submitted will not be returned.
5. All photocopies must be on A4 size paper.
